PTE Enrolment and Academic Records Amendment Rules 2016

1. Authority

1.1 These Rules are made under section 253 of the Education Act 1989 (the Act).

2. Commencement

2.1 These Rules commence on the day after the date of approval by the Minister under section 253(5) of the Act.

3. Amendment to the Principal Rules

3.1 These Rules amend the PTE Enrolment and Academic Records Rules 2012 (the **Principal Rules**).

4. Rule 6.2 replaced (Student academic records)

- 4.1 Replace Rule 6.2 with:
 - 6.2 PTEs must keep all student assessment materials generated from education or training in which students are enrolled, or full copies of them, for at least 12 months from the date of completion of that education or training (for the avoidance of doubt, this includes assessment materials of education or training provided by sub-contractors of the PTE).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the Rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This amendment to the Principal Rules, which commences on the day after the date of approval by the Minister under section 253(5) of the Act, requires all PTEs to keep student assessment materials for 12 months from the completion of education or training they are enrolled in (*including that of its sub-contractors*), to ensure assessment evidence is available should it be required.
