

Aligning Te Marautanga o Aotearoa subjects and standards with the University Entrance approved subjects list

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The New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) is seeking views on a proposal to align subjects and standards from the Māori-medium curriculum, *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa*, with the University Entrance approved subjects list.

Te Marautanga o Aotearoa is the foundation curriculum document for Māori-medium education. It outlines the core learning and competencies of Māori-medium students, including the skills and knowledge required to enter university and follow chosen careers.

The proposal would enable:

- Māori-medium students to continue their learning within Māori-medium up to and including NCEA Level 3 and be eligible to have their learning recognised for University Entrance
- learning from *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa* to count towards the University Entrance requirement for 14 credits in each of three subjects on the approved subjects list.
