General knowledge quiz

NZQA has developed a general knowledge quiz as an activity that enables students to test their knowledge of digital infrastructure (e.g. internet speeds) for the purposes of completing Digital Infrastructure. The use of a quiz was a suggestion from teacher focus groups.

The quiz takes about 20 minutes to complete. We suggest each school to complete the quiz activity at the same time, using the expected infrastructure. This activity is intended to be used by schools participating in the Digital Trials and Pilots on any given day.
