

# New Zealand Qualifications Authority Guidelines for 2011 Christchurch Credit Inclusion

## Eligibility:

All students who were enrolled in an earthquake affected school on 22 February (including those now in schools outside of Christchurch) or who enrolled in an earthquake affected school after 22 February but before 1 September, and who have narrowly missed being awarded their Level 3 NCEA or University Entrance may apply for up to six unspecified credits towards their level 3 NCEA. Three of these unspecified credits may also be used towards the 42 credits required for University Entrance.

These unspecified credits will not be assigned to any subject or course and they will not contribute to either the University Entrance literacy or numeracy requirement.

Applications may be made after the release of results in January, with a **closing date of 17 February 2012**. Universities will be advised where unspecified credits were used towards University Entrance.

Students who moved out of Christchurch after the 22 February earthquake are eligible to apply for **Christchurch Earthquake Credit Inclusion** provided their application is supported by their new school.
