Explanatory Notes

- Demonstrate understanding of a key role within a Te Ao Haka* involves:
 - describing a role that contributes to a Te Ao Haka performance;
 - discuss its function, and how the requirements of the role align with the skills obtained during the study of Te Ao Haka.

Evaluate a key role within Te Ao Haka involves:

- examining important moments experienced in the preparation for and execution of the role;
- exploring the ways in which an effective or ineffective execution of the role can impact on the performance.

Analyse a key role within Te Ao Haka involves:

- examining the role in the wider context of Te Ao Haka including discussing its tikanga.

3 A *key role* is a role in which, if the participant had not been present, the resulting performance would have been noticeably different.

Students must select one of the following key roles:

- being the kaitātaki wahine or kaitātaki tāne
- performing a solo or duet
- being a mentor to other students
- playing a musical instrument to support a performance
- being a tā-moko artist for the team
- being in charge of costumes
- creating taonga (i.e. poi) for the performance.

4 *Important moments* refers to points during the process of preparing for and executing a role in which deliberate action is required in order to achieve a desired result.

Examples of important moments include:

- before the role: earning and being chosen for the role
- during the role: rehearsing or practising
- during the role: overcoming a barrier or mistake
- during the role: being prepared for success
- during the performance: following through and executing the role.

Quality Assurance

1 Ko tēnei Paerewa Paetae, he mea ahu mai i te *New Zealand Curriculum*, Learning Media, Ministry of Education, 2007, ā, ka hāngai ki ngā whāinga o ngā Whakaaro Whānui ki Taumata 8 o te *Tukutuku Ako o Te Ao Haka ki ngā Taumata 6, 7, 8*. 2 Ka whai wāhi ki te *whakaatu māramatanga ki tētahi tūranga tāpua i roto i Te Ao Haka*:

- te whakaahua i tētahi tūranga e whai koha ana ki tētahi whakaaturanga i Te Ao Haka;
- te matapaki i tōna āheinga, i te āhua hoki o te hāngai o ngā herenga o te tūranga ki ngā pūkenga ka mau i te wā o te rangahau i Te Ao Haka.

Ka whai wāhi ki te *arotake i tētahi tūranga tāpua i roto i Te Ao Haka*:

- te mātai i ngā wā whakahirahira ka rangona i te whakaritenga me te whakatutukihanga o ngā mahi o te tūranga;
- te tūhura i ngā ara e pāngia ai pea te whakaaturanga e te whai hua o te whakatutuki i te tūranga, e te korenga rānei o te whakatutukihanga i whai hua.

Ka whai wāhi ki te *tātari i tētahi tūranga tāpua i roto i Te Ao Haka*:

- te mātai i te tūranga i te horopaki whānui ake o Te Ao Haka, tae atu ki te matapaki i ana tikanga.

- 3 Ko tētahi *tūranga tāpua*, ko te tūranga e tino kitea ai, e tino rangona ai hoki rānei te rerekētanga i te korenga o te kaihāpai i taua tūranga i reira.

Me kōwhiri te ākonga i tētahi o ēnei tūranga tāpua e whai ake nei:

- te tū hei kaitātaki wahine, hei kaitātaki tāne rānei
- te whakaatu i tētahi hīanga, i tētahi waiata takirua rānei
- te ārahi i ētahi atu ākonga
- te whakatangi i tētahi taonga puoro hei kīnaki i te whakaaturanga
- te tū hei kaitā moko i te kapa
- te tiaki kākahu
- te waihanga taonga (pēnei i te poi) mō te whakaaturanga.

- 4 E kōrero ana ngā *wā whakahirahira* mō ngā wā o te tukanga hei whakarite, hei whakatutuki hoki i te tūranga me āta mahi e puta ai te hua e whāia ana.

Ko ētahi wā whakahirahira:

- i mua i te tūranga: ko te eke a te tangata i ngā taumata e tika ai te tohua ōna ki te tūranga
- i te wā o te tūranga: ko te whakaharatau, ko te whakawai rānei
- i te wā o te tūranga: ko te kake i tētahi taupā, i tētahi hapa rānei
- i te wā o te tūranga: ko te whakarite kia angitu
- i te wā o te whakaaturanga: ko te whai kia eke rā anō, kia tutuki te tūranga.

Tātari Kounga

- 1 Me mātua whakaae ngā kura me ngā whare mātauranga e te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa kia whakahaere aromatawai i mua i tā rātou rēhita i ngā whiwhinga i ngā aromatawai e hāngai ana ki ngā paerewa paetae.
- 2 Me pāhekoheko rawa ngā kura me ngā whare mātauranga, kua whakaaetia tā rātou aromatawai, ki te pūnaha mātairua e hāngai ana ki aua paerewa paetae.
