

Two	A4	The candidate demonstrated a good understanding of the text and communicated the relevant ideas in their answers. Some inconsistencies were noted, such as referencing a party and Sylvie being impatient.
Three	А3	The candidate identified some of the relevant aspects of information, ideas, and opinions from the text. A number of inconsistencies were present, such as picking up her grandmother and having access to only one charging station.
