### Purpose

This qualification is for people who work in general or specialist roles in the agricultural contracting sector. This qualification may follow on from the National Certificate in Rural Contracting (Introductory Skills) [Ref: 0228] and people completing it may choose to progress to the National Certificate in Rural Contracting (Management) with strands in Agrichemical Contracting, and Agricultural Contracting [Ref: 1003].

People who have met the requirements of the compulsory section are able to demonstrate knowledge of tractor safety, vehicles and loads in agricultural contracting, and the communications requirements for their work. They are able to maintain health and safety in their workplace, carry out first aid, complete driving logbooks, drive a basic wheel tractor on flat terrain, and for agricultural contracting purposes, produce and confirm a plan to carry out a basic operation and perform basic measurement and calculations.

To complete the qualification they must be able to demonstrate a range of further knowledge and skills suited to their particular circumstances including, but not limited to, specific agricultural contracting knowledge and skills.

The holder may be able to demonstrate specialist agricultural contracting competence by completing one or more of the following optional strands:

- Crop Production
- Fencing
- Harvesting
- Land Development
- Mechanical Vegetation Control
- Transport
- Zero Tillage.

An optional strand may be achieved:

- 1 in addition to completing the requirements of the qualification (the qualification being comprised of the Core Compulsory and the Core Elective); OR
- 2 with shared credits between the strand and the Core Elective. This second provision does not apply to the Fencing optional strand, which has no shared credits with the Core Elective.

## Special Notes

- 1 Candidates who achieve credit for standards 21563 and 21564 may be eligible for Approved Handler test certification. Approved Handler test certificates are issued only by Test Certifiers appointed under Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 (HSNO) legislation. **Transition Arrangements****Version 6**

Version 6 was issued following revision of the qualification to include an essential unit standard in the Transport optional strand.

Changes to structure and content

- Credit tables were updated.
- Standard 23436 was added as a compulsory standard for the Transport optional strand.
- The credit total for the qualification with the Transport strand was increased from 94 to 98.
- The prerequisite diagram was corrected and updated.

InfraTrain recommends that trainees who wish to complete the Transport strand transfer their results to version 6 so that they meet current legislative requirements.

Other trainees currently working towards version 5 of this qualification may either complete the requirements for that version or transfer their results to this version by December 2011.

New trainees will be enrolled in programmes leading to the new version of the qualification.

## Previous versions of the qualification

Version 5 was issued following a review that amended the overall purpose and content of the qualification.

### Changes to structure and content

All strands were registered as optional strands, with the qualification able to be achieved with the Core Compulsory and Core Elective only. Minimum credits for the qualification were changed from 86-147 to 69. Core Compulsory reduced from 33 to 29 credits, and Core Elective increased from 27 to 40 credits. Core Compulsory: standards 6258, 6469, and 19579 were removed; and standard 23622 was added. Core Compulsory standard 6255 was moved to the Harvesting optional strand. Standard 24552 replaced standard 19043 in the Core Compulsory. Standards 6400 and 16701 were moved from the Core Compulsory to the Core Elective Set B. Core Elective was split into Set A and Set B and standards 6256, 6257, 6267, 6290, 19562, 19574, 19575, and 19576 within the Core Elective were replaced by Set A with the requirement to select a minimum of 25 credits from the *Agricultural Contracting* domain. Standard 1766 was removed, and standards 6917, 19046, 20627, 20798, 20877, 20878, 21563, and 21564 were added to the Core Elective. Standard 6466 was moved from the Core Elective to the new Transport optional strand. Standard 9707 was moved from the Core Elective to the Core Compulsory. Standard 15164 was removed from the Core Elective, and was substituted by standard 24089 in the Core Compulsory. Two new optional strands were added – Fencing and Transport. Crop Production and Zero Tillage strands were replaced by the Crop Production and Zero Tillage optional strands. Standards 6271, 6272, 6274, and 19568 were removed from the Crop Production optional strand. Standard 6275 was moved from the Crop Production strand Compulsory to the Crop Production optional strand Elective Set A. Standard 6266 was moved from the Crop Production Elective Set A to the Crop Production optional strand Elective Set B. Standard 23638 replaced standard 6268 within the Crop Production optional strand Elective sets. Standard 19063 was added to the Crop Production optional strand Compulsory and the Zero Tillage optional strand. Standard 23436 was added to the Transport strand as a Compulsory. Harvesting strand was replaced by the Harvesting optional strand. Standards 6273, 6279, 6285, 6287, 6288, 6289, and 19572 were removed, and standards 23624-23626, 23629-23637, and 23639 were added to the Harvesting optional strand. Hedge Trimming and Mowing strands were replaced by the Mechanical Vegetation Control optional strand. Standard 6479 was moved from the Mowing strand to the Land Development strand. All standards from the Hedge Trimming strand were moved to the Mechanical Vegetation Control optional strand. Standards 5627, 19570, 19571, and 19576 were moved from the Mowing strand to the Mechanical Vegetation Control optional strand. Standard 23623 was added to the Mechanical Vegetation Control strand. Land Drainage and Land Development strands were replaced by the Land Development optional strand. Standards 6260, 6261, 6266, 6283, 6284, 6479, 19562-19564, and 19575 were moved from the Land Drainage and Land Development strands to the Land Development optional strand. Standard 23638 replaced standard 6280 within the Land Development optional strand Elective. Standards 19565-19567 and 19574 were removed, and standards 6476, 17309, 17311, 17314, 17316, 17317, 23621, and 23623 were added to the Land Development optional strand.

Version 4 was issued following review to make changes as a result of a review of unit standards in the *Agricultural Contracting* domain.



**Changes to structure and content**

Title was changed to include new strands. Total credits were changed from 54-98 to 86-147. Standards 4, 497, 3461, 3462, 3471, 8489, 8490, and 8492 were removed from core compulsory and units 1277, 6469, 16701, 19577, 19578, and 19579 were added. New core elective was added. In Crop Production strand – standards 6472, 6274, and 6275 were moved to compulsory from strand elective lists; new standard 19568 was added to elective A; standard 6276 added to elective B; and elective list C removed. In Land Drainage Strand – standard 6479 was added to compulsory, standards 6260 and 6261 were moved to elective, and standards 19563 and 19564 were added to elective. In Land Development Strand – compulsory changed to new elective list A with standard 6259 removed and standards 19574 and 19575 added; original list A changed to list B with standard 6266 added, 6282 removed and standard 6281 replaced by standards 19565, 19566, and 19567; original list B removed. In Hedge Trimming Strand – elective removed and standards 5627, 5628, and 19576 added to compulsory. In Harvesting Strand – standard 6285 moved from compulsory to elective and standards 19570 and 19572 added to elective. New strands in Mowing, and Zero Tillage added. Credit and level tables were amended to show new strands and new electives. Prerequisite diagrams were updated and reorganised to show strands. Reference to standard setting body name was changed from NZ Contracting ITO to InfraTrain New Zealand Ltd.

Version 3 was issued in order to amend the level and credit tables and update the standard listings and SSB information. Reviewed *Driving* and *Core Health* standards were updated; standard 3463 was removed; standard 6401 added.

Version 2 was issued to reflect the *Horticulture*, *Mathematics*, *Forestry*, and *Agriculture* standard reviews. Most of the standards in the domain of *Land Skills* were moved to new domains – *Agricultural Resource Maintenance* and *Agricultural Vehicles and Machinery* which were added to the elective section of this qualification.

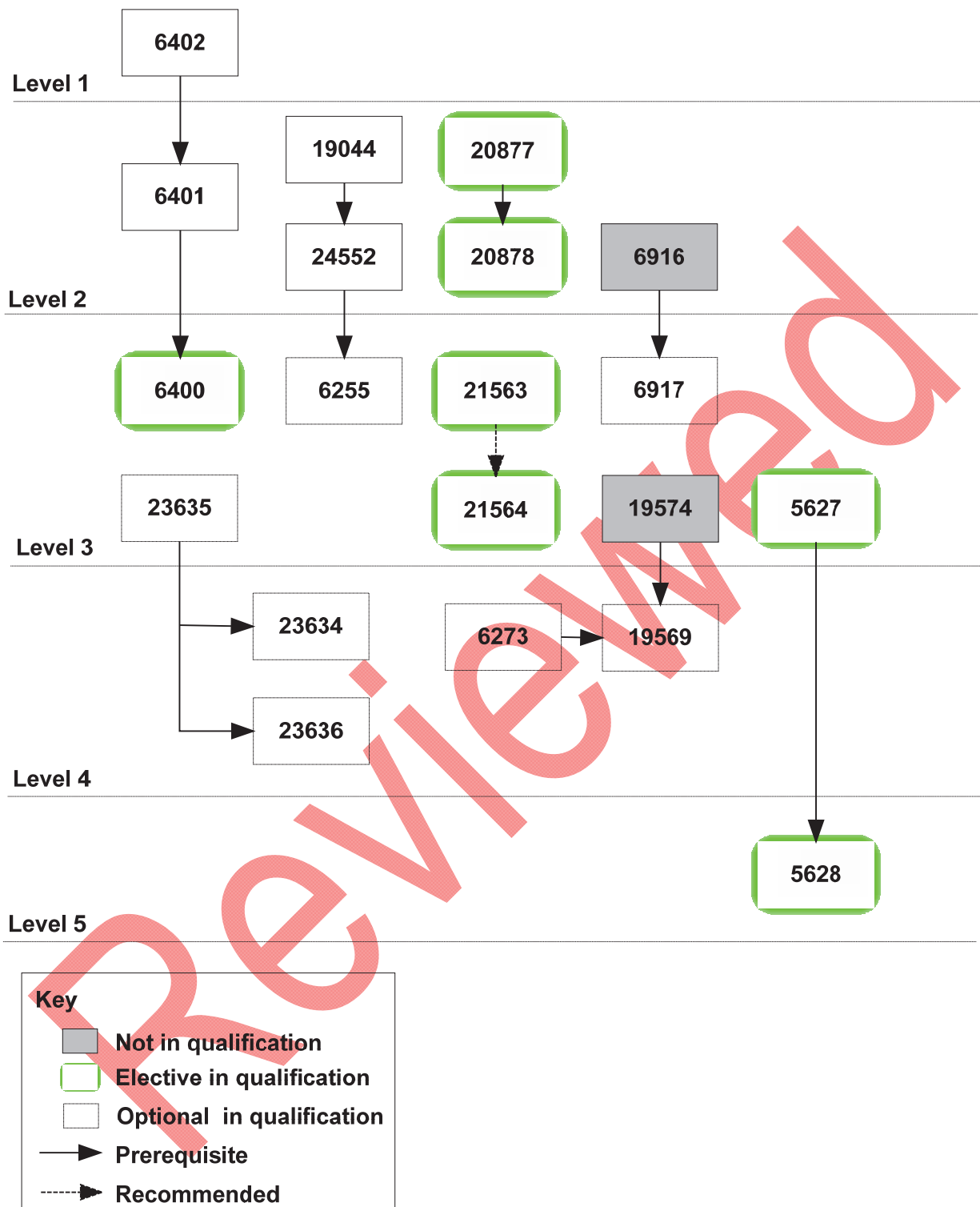
