

National Certificate in Manufacturing (Leatherwork) with strands in Saddlemaking, and Leather Goods Manufacture

Level 3

Credits 146-172

This qualification is **expiring**. The last date to meet the requirements is 31 December 2011.

Purpose

This qualification recognises the skills and knowledge competencies for people working in the saddlemaking and leather goods manufacturing industry. The unit standards specified are a combination of the industry specific trade knowledge and skills required and the complementary generic knowledge and skills required to work within the commercial environment.

All holders of this certificate are able to identify leather hides and skins, make patterns, perform calculations, set up and use a sewing machine, use and maintain tools and equipment, and cut materials. They are able to meet customers and attend to their enquiries.

In the saddlemaking strand, people are able to make leather and synthetic saddles, repair saddles, make and repair strappings and mountings, make and repair trotting and pacing harnesses, and make animal covers.

In the leather goods manufacture strand, people are able to carry out skiving operations, fold and bagged edge treatments, and gold blocking operations. They are able to assemble and make hand and shoulder bags and small leather goods.

The qualification is a stand-alone qualification and is designed to recognise generic skills as well as workplace skills. There are a number of Canvas Fabrication unit standards in the qualification, which may lead on to the National Certificate in Canvas Fabrication [Ref: 0079].

Previous versions of the qualification

Version 2 was reviewed and issued to improve the structure and content of the qualification; to take account of changes resulting from the review of canvas fabrication unit standards; and to extend the period of registration.

Changes to structure and content

- unit standards 3338, 3363, and 3371 were removed from the core compulsory section;
- unit standards 3368, 3373, 3374, and 3379 were removed from the Leather Goods Manufacture strand;
- reviewed unit standards were updated;
- minimum credit total for the Leather Goods Manufacture strand was reduced from 70 to 44;
- credit total for the qualification was decreased from 184 to 146-172.
