Ngā Mahi a te Whare Pora (Pae Tuatoru) (Level 6)

1 purpose

The National Diploma in Ngā Mahi a te Whare Pora (Pae Tuatoru) (Level 6) is an advanced qualification that recognises achievement in the production aspects of Raranga.

The compulsory section recognises the underpinning tāniko and whāriki skills and knowledge of all role holders. The elective sections from the fields of Arts and Crafts, and Māori are included to support the range of programmes providers can offer and to enable candidates to specialise in an area of choice.

This diploma builds on the knowledge and skills recognised by the National Certificate in Ngā Mahi a te Whare Pora (Pae Tuarua) (Level 4) [Ref: 0706].

Whakaruruhau - Raranga and the National Standards Body Māori both endorse the concept of lifelong learning and encourage people to consider future options on offer that build on this qualification, and, to enhance their career pathways.

2 regulations for the qualification**2.1 entry information for programmes of education and training assessed against the unit standards in the qualification**

Prerequisite: the National Certificate in Ngā Mahi a te Whare Pora (Pae Tuarua) (Level 4) [Ref: 0706] or demonstrate equivalent knowledge and skills.

2.2 recognition of prior learning

People may apply to accredited providers for recognition of prior learning. Applications for recognition of prior learning can also be made to National Standards Body Māori for facilitation and coordination purposes.

The National Diploma in Ngā Mahi a te Whare Pora (Pae Tuatoru) (Level 6) will be awarded to people credited with all of the compulsory unit standards and who have met the requirements of the elective section.
