

## National Certificate in Community Recreation (Aquatics) (Level 4)

### Purpose

This qualification recognises the skills and knowledge required for leading aquatic recreation programmes, activities or facilities in the community. It provides candidates the opportunity to study aquatic recreation leadership and specialty areas including pre-hospital care and workplace training. There is an additional emphasis on maintaining safety in an aquatic environment, through risk management, safety, and swimming pool water treatment standards. This represents the skill sets and knowledge required of team leaders and senior operational staff working in the aquatic recreation industry more closely.

The National Certificate in Community Recreation (Aquatics) (Level 4) contains the standards required for the National Pool Lifeguard Award, and includes electives that recognise broad skills in the provision of aquatic recreation services including health and safety management, emergency response, leading teams and workplace training and development, and water treatment.

This qualification builds on from and shares some common standards with the National Certificate in Community Recreation (Aquatics) (Level 3) [Ref: 0937]. It shares some common standards with and may lead onto the National Certificate in Community Recreation (Programme and Event Management) (Level 4) [Ref: 0939].

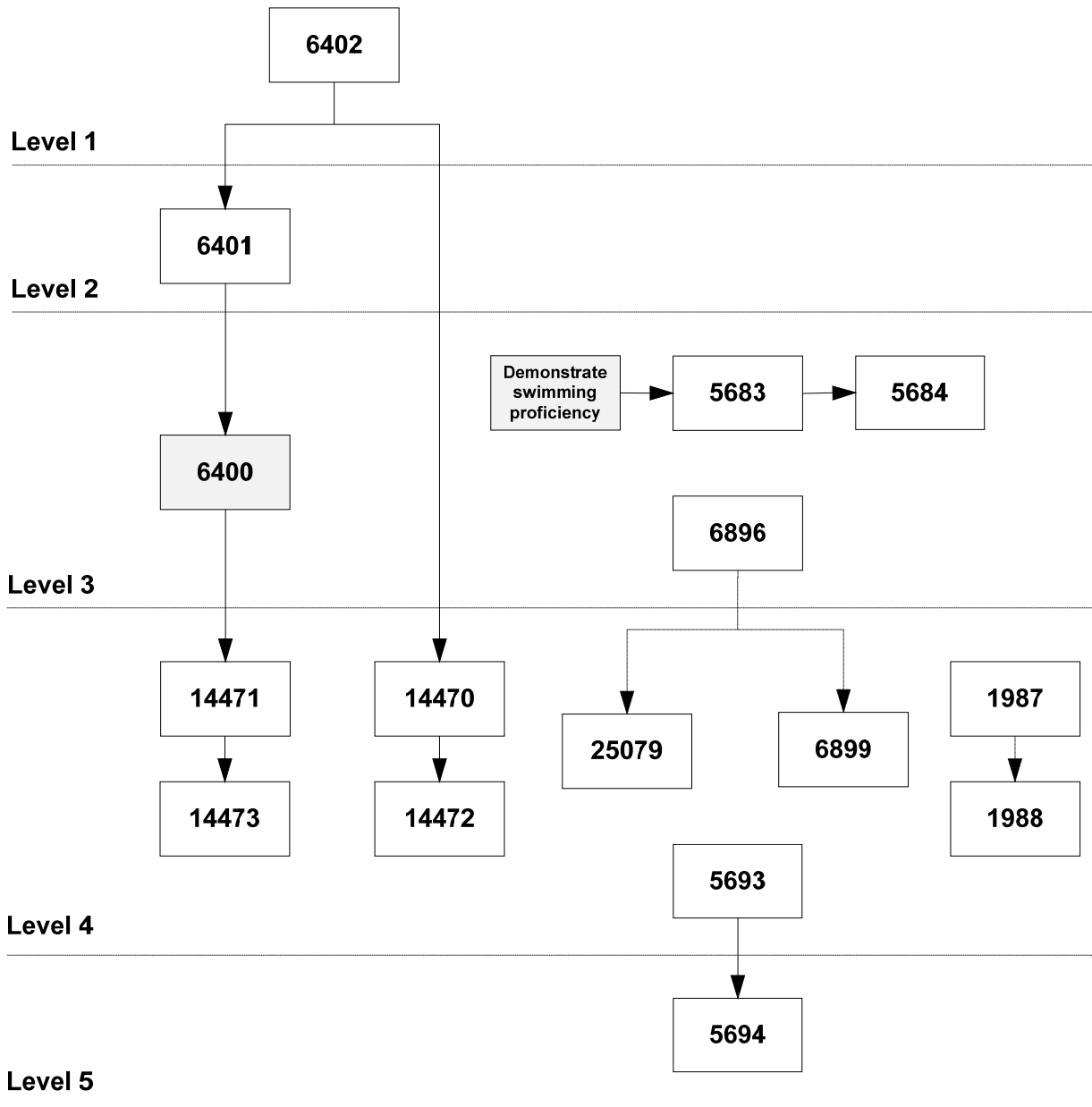
