This qualification is designed for people with responsibility for running complex programmes and events. Holders of this qualification have demonstrated their ability in the areas recreation management, programmes and events, communication skills, business administration and first line management.

This qualification is at a professional level, targeted at people who have the responsibility of planning and running complex programmes and events, and for managing a team. It also shares some common unit standards with and may lead onto the National Diploma in Community Recreation (Programme and Event Management) (Level 6) [Ref: 0941].
