#### Outcome 1

Describe aspects of one's own whakapapa, heritage, and cultural identity.

- 1.3 An event in family history, before one's birth, that has impact in the present is identified, and its effect on self is described.
- 1.4 Three cultural characteristics that are general to one's own cultural identity are identified in terms of their application to self.

1.5 Two examples that illustrate own expression of cultural identity are identified.
