#### Performance criteria

3.1 Information is found using simple and advanced search techniques.

Range simple techniques include but are not limited to – keywords,

phrases, find within a webpage;

advanced techniques include but are not limited to – Boolean operators, search restrictions (time specific, domain type, country,

file types), and

may include - voice search.

3.2 Search results are evaluated in terms of the relevance and provenance of the

information found.

Range a minimum of two pieces of information from each of the two

search engines.
