- 2.6 Use tools and equipment appropriate for the task.
- 2.7 Clean and store tools after use.
- 2.8 Maintain records, report workplace information, and report any problems related to ground-based duties.

Outcome 3

Work safely around other people and machinery on an arboriculture site.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Demonstrate awareness and safe practices when carrying out arboriculture duties around colleagues who are working from the ground and at heights.
- 3.2 Demonstrate awareness and safe practices when carrying out arboriculture duties around machinery working on an aboriculture site.
