Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Provide leadership to another practitioner(s) to enhance their adult education and training practice.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Practitioner is supported to reflect on, and identify opportunities to enhance their practice, in accordance with their personal and professional requirements.

- 1.2 Practitioner is supported to develop a plan of action to meet agreed outcomes and identify critical success factors.
- Range agreed outcomes may be individual as well as organisational.
- 1.3 Practitioner is supported to implement plan and critical success factors are monitored.
- 1.4 Practitioner is supported to adapt plan to incorporate any changes/improvements to practitioner practice.
- 1.5 The effectiveness of the plan is reviewed in collaboration with the practitioner(s).
