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### Guidance Information

- 1 Definition  
*Community* refers to an environment relevant to the activity and to the candidate, and could be physical and/or digital.
- 2 The activity must take place over a time period that allows for sufficient evidence to be gathered of candidate's performance.
- 3 The activity could be completed by one person, or by a group provided each candidate can provide sufficient evidence for the assessment of their individual performance.
- 4 The activity must be of sufficient complexity to align with the descriptor for Level 3, available in *The New Zealand Qualifications Framework* at [Understanding the New Zealand Qualifications Framework \(NZQF\) » NZQA](#)

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Plan and engage in an activity intended to benefit the community.

Range plan includes – intended outcome, intended benefits, timeframe and milestones, budget, personnel, record-keeping, constraints, communications and/or publicity, risk assessment and contingencies.

1.3 Liaison with the community and people intended to benefit is maintained before, during, and after the activity.

1.4 Activity is evaluated in terms of its intended benefits.

Range evaluation includes – a comparison between benefits intended and realised, feedback from the community, personal reflection.
