element 1

Carry out pre incident building inspection for fire and rescue risk planning.

performance criteria

- 1.2 A risk plan is developed to meet the requirements of the National Commander's Instructions.

element 2

Prepare and submit documentation.

performance criteria

- 2.1 Information is collated from the inspections in accordance with the requirements of the National Commander's Instructions.
- 2.2 Building sketch plans are drawn and show details to meet the requirements of the National Commander's Instructions.
- 2.3 Risk plan is submitted to meet the requirements of the National Commander's Instructions.
