Comprehensively describe a social institution means to describe the role norms and values play in maintaining/reproducing the social institution. The description must be supported with a range of appropriate evidence and examples.

3 Definition

A social institution organises the basic areas of social life and contributes to complex integrated sets of norms and values, which are reproduced through institutions such as (but not limited to): family and kinship, government, law and order, economy, education, media, health, and religion.
