



'Universal' Record of Achievement survey: closed-ended questions results

Q1. I know what the current Record of Achievement is?





Q2. I have used the current Record of Achievement.





Q4. It would be useful for me to have a 'Universal' Record of Achievement, now and in the future.





Q7. What is your age-group?





COMPREHENSIVE
<p>"I am currently working towards a degree through Massey University. It would be great to have this achievement shown on there once I have completed, would give a quick overview of all my achievements in one place". 30+</p> <p>"To enable an easily accessed and easily understood record of all tertiary papers that have been completed. This is particularly relevant if you have not completed a degree but have completed papers towards one." 30+</p> <p>"It would be good to have all qualifications that are accredited by NZQA listed on the ROA not just national Certificates/Diplomas. That way Educational institutes and employers can see all qualifications in one go rather than having to have individual transcripts verified". 30+</p> <p>"If the qualification is NZQA accredited, then it should be listed. LIFELONG LEARNING
<p>"Because it's great to have all of your records throughout your life." 16-18</p> <p>"At present my learning is spread between different courses I do through professional development i.e. Open Polytechnic and work related. Often hard to get a final list of what I have achieved". 30+</p> <p>"A lifetime and ranged record would be nice in terms of proof of achievement for personal but also for use in applying for university/polytechnic and even jobs". 19-23</p> <p>"More and more, people are encouraged to become 'lifelong learners', and so could be learning through a range of education institutions. This would make it so much easier to keep track of a person's accomplishments and achievements". 30+</p>
TRANSFER
<p>"Because I am planning to do long term course once I finish my school and it's not decided that I will continue my study in New Zealand for all of my study, so it will be useful for me to have a Universal Record of Achievement.
