Annual Fee Amendment Rules 2022

1. Authority

1.1 These Rules are made under:

- (a) section 452(1)(d) of the Education and Training Act 2020 in respect of the annual registration fee for registered establishments; and
- (b) section 48 of the Legislation Act 2019 and clause 48(2)(h) of Schedule 1 of the Education and Training Act, for the purposes of section 11F of the Industry Training and Apprenticeships Act 1992, in respect of the revocation of the annual fee for transitional ITOs.

2. Commencement and application

2.1 These Rules commence on the 28th day after the date of approval by the Minister under section 452(5) of the Act.

3. Annual Fee Rules 2021 amended

3.1 Rule 6.1 of the Annual Fee Rules 2021 (the principal Rules) is amended by adding '*in arrears*' after the words '*calendar year*'.

3.2 The following revocations are made to the principal Rules with effect from 1 January 2023:

- (a) the definitions of **ITA Act** and **transitional ITO** in rule 3.1;
- (b) Part 2, in both the Contents and in the body of the principal Rules.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of these Rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This amendment to the principal Rules, which commences on the 28th day after the date of approval by the Minister under section 452(5) of the Act, clarifies that the annual fee for registered establishments is payable in arrears, and revokes definitions and rules in relation to the annual fee for transitional ITOs. The transition period for transitional ITOs ends with

the close of 31 December 2022, after which transitional ITOs lose their status as a transitional ITO.
