### Ihirangi waitohu | Indicative content

- learning should be inclusive of local tikanga practices of mana whenua
- kōrero tuku iho is used in relation to ngā pūrākau, pakiwaitara, Māori history, oral traditions, concepts, and values of local iwi and/or mana whenua and hapori
- basic use of te reo
- identify specific pūkenga for a selected context
- identify the benefits of pūkengatanga to self and whānau well-being
- whānau – special occasions, preparing for manuhiri, caring for whānau
- marae – pōwhiri, kapa haka, hura kōhatu, celebrations, tangihanga
- employment mahi – orientation, job description, health and safety
