

## **Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2014 (EXPIRED)**

### **1. Authority, commencement and application**

- a These Rules are made under section 253 (1) (j) of the Education Act 1989 in respect of assessment (including examinations) carried out in relevant schools with consent to assess.
- b These Rules replace the Assessment and Examination Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2013 (which are consequentially revoked) and are effective from 1 February 2014 until the end of 31 January 2015.
- c These Rules specify the [general requirements](#) for assessment (including examination) in relevant schools with consent to assess involving the:
  - i New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF) and standards on the Directory of Assessment Standards
  - ii New Zealand Scholarship (2014)
  - iii New Zealand University Entrance.
- d The principles of fairness, validity and transparency of assessment practice for all candidates are fundamental to the administration of qualifications in schools and underpin these Rules.
