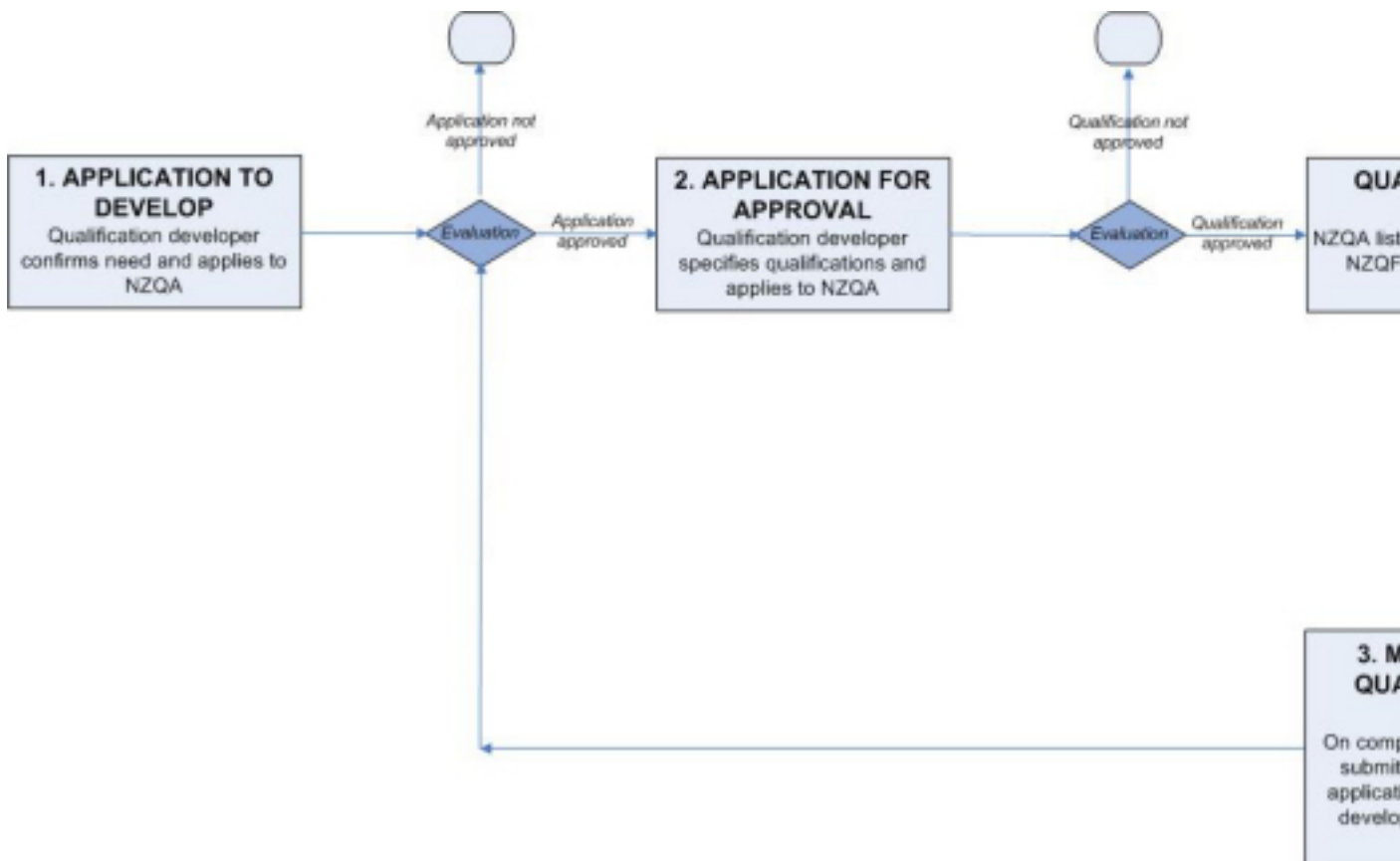
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Developing and reviewing qualifications at Levels 1-6 on the NZQF

All qualifications listed on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework must meet the requirements outlined in Section 3 of the policy document, [The New Zealand Qualifications Framework \(PDF, 527KB\)](#). They must also be approved by the relevant quality assurance body.

New Zealand qualifications at Levels 1-6 were introduced in 2011 following a [targeted review of qualifications](#). The requirements for listing New Zealand qualifications are outlined in Section 4 of the policy document.
