A modernised, learner-friendly interface

A redesigned interface gives new functionalities and features, allowing



- display their most relevant and/or up-to-date qualifications and
- access a separate tab with their contact details, which they can use to update their record
- add the education organisation that awarded the qualification
- preview and save an electronic copy of their official record, then the authenticity of the transcript can be verified using a document verification feature

Designed to evolve with future needs

As an official electronic document, the New Zealand Record of Achievement will provide a secure and accessible record of a learner's achievements.

The Record will continue to display NCEA standards, endorsements and other qualifications achieved across the 10 levels of [the New Zealand Qualifications Framework](#).

As other education-wide projects progress, the record will show other types of assessment standards. The New Zealand Record of Achievement will continue to evolve to meet the needs of learners and education providers.

This approach will ensure that learners' records are as comprehensive as possible for further learning, and will support lifelong learners.

Learners will be able to access the new interface and customise their Achievements in late May 2017.
