Section 1: Information for the Dance teacher

1. Assessment overview

Information supporting NCEA Dance external assessment 2022 for standards: NCEA Levels 1-3

The following standards require the showing of a DVD recording of an extract from a dance work to all candidates. This DVD will be produced by the school.

Level 1 90861	<i>Demonstrate understanding of a dance performance</i>
Level 2 91211	<i>Provide an interpretation of a dance performance with supporting evidence</i>
Level 3 91594	<i>Analyse a dance performance</i>

1.1 Preparation of Dance recordings

For each of the standards, schools will record a dance extract of 3-6 minutes which meets the 2022 [Assessment Specifications](#).

Where the recording is not a recording listed in the specifications, the recording must be provided in a link accessible to NZQA.

The file name must identify the school code, the NCEA level and the extract name.

For example: schoolcodeL1Extractname.mp4

For example: 0332L1Poorboy.mp4.

If an .mp4 version is not available, the file type must be able to be played within a Windows environment using either VLC or Windows media player.

The recording will contain only the work that is to be viewed by the candidates during the examination.

1.2 Resources to be provided by schools

Schools will:

- provide access to TWO copies of the recording to the Exam Centre Manager
- supply a device that will play the recording to a screen of at least 60 cm (25”) in the examination room
- check that both recordings play on the device being used in the examination room
- supply extra copies of recording and extra equipment if there are candidates with special assessment conditions requiring separate accommodation.
