

Tutorial on exemptions:

Narration	Page to Show
<p>When you're going hard to gain course endorsements, it's important to know that some courses have exemptions. This means the usual requirements - at least 3 internal and 3 external credits – may not apply.</p> <p>Let me show you what I mean.</p>	<p>ANDREA to CAMERA</p>
<p>Here's my Religious Studies course. All of the standards are marked with an asterisk because they are all exempt from the external assessment rule. That's because there are no externally assessed Religious Studies standards.</p> <p>The exemption the standards relate to is stated right here, below the list of entries.</p>	<p>Viewing <b>Religious Studies 101</b></p>
<p>When I look at the credits required to meet the external assessment rule, it says 'Exempt'.</p>	<p>Scroll down to criteria summary</p>
<p>So, I know that to gain an endorsement for this course, I don't have to meet the external assessment rule. Now let's take a look at a different example, my Physical Education course.</p>	<p>ANDREA to CAMERA</p>
<p>Again, you can see my Physical Education standards are marked with an asterisk. But this course also has some Health standards in it.</p> <p>When I look at the external assessment rule for this course, it doesn't say 'Exempt'.</p>	<p>Click into <b>Physical Education 102</b>.</p>
<p>That's because I could use the Health standards to get an endorsement without using the exemption.</p> <p>But, what if I remove the the externally assessed health standard?</p>	<p>ANDREA to CAMERA</p>
<p>Ah ha, I'd now need to use the exemption to get an endorsement, so the rule is now showing exempt.</p>	<p>Remove EX standard</p>
<p>If I need to use the exemption, I can only use the exempt standards.</p> <p>So, I can't use any of the Health standards to get an endorsement using the Physical Education exemption.</p>	<p>ANDREA to CAMERA</p>
<p>Exemptions can also relate to internally assessed credits. For instance, in my Painting course.</p>	<p>ANDREA to CAMERA (change framing)</p>
<p>All the standards are for Level 3 Visual Arts. Because the externally assessed standard is worth a whopping 14 credits by itself, two exemptions are possible: I can get an endorsement using just the externally assessed standard, or I could get one using just the internally assessed standards.</p>	<p>Click through to <b>Painting 301</b></p>
<p>None of the rules are showing as 'Exempt' because I can use my internals and my external to get an endorsement without an exemption.</p>	<p>Scroll down to criteria summary</p>
<p>Because I'm just doing the Painting standards, I don't have enough internally assessed credits in this course to get an endorsement just using my internals. So I can't use that exemption. But if the results in my internals aren't good enough, I can use the other exemption and get an endorsement just with my external.</p>	<p>Update internals with A's and update. Scroll down to see credit summary saying exempt.</p>
<p>This tool makes it pretty easy to figure out exactly what exemptions are possible when you're aiming for endorsements in your courses; but remember, if you have any questions at all, talk to your teacher.</p>	<p>ANDREA to CAMERA</p>
