Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Catch, restrain and lift livestock manually within safe and personal limits.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Catch and restrain livestock securely using Worksafe New Zealand recommended methods.
- 1.2 Lift livestock securely using Worksafe New Zealand recommended methods.
- 1.3 Restrain and lift livestock without injury or undue risk of injury to animal, handler or others.

Outcome 2

Move a herd or mob of livestock, as directed by the supervisor, without assistance.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Move livestock safely, without stress and with least risk of injury to animal.
- 2.2 Anticipate and control livestock behaviour in accordance with the relevant code of welfare.
- 2.3 Move livestock in a time specified, and in accordance with prior instructions from the supervisor.
