

<b>Title</b>	<b>Identify, remove, and fit zips in the industrial textile fabrication industry</b>

<b>Purpose</b>	People credited with this unit standard are able to identify and remove zips from existing products; and fit zips to materials in the industrial textile fabrication industry.

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### Guidance Information

- 1 Evidence presented for assessment against this unit standard must be consistent with safe working practices and be in accordance with applicable manufacturer's information, company requirements, industry guidelines and legislative requirements. This includes the knowledge and use of suitable tools and equipment.
- 2 Legislation, regulations and/or industry standards relevant to this unit standard include but are not limited to the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015; and any subsequent amendments and replacements.
- 3 Definitions  
*Company requirements* refers to instructions to staff on policy and procedures that are available in the workplace. These requirements may include – company policies and procedures, work instructions, product quality specifications and legislative requirements.  
*Industry guidelines* refers to those practices and procedures commonly used as standard procedures to produce items of acceptable merchantable quality in the industrial textile fabrication industry such as related textbook descriptors.  
*Manufacturer's information* may include – technical information for a machine or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.
- 4 It is recommended that people seeking credit for this unit standard first hold credit for Unit 23497, *Demonstrate knowledge of zips used in the industrial textile fabrication industry*.
- 5 Evidence of three separate zips being removed and fitted correctly is required.

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## Outcomes and performance criteria

### Outcome 1

Identify and remove zips from existing products in the industrial textile fabrication industry.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Type of material from which zips are to be removed is identified.
- 1.2 Types and sizes of zips to be removed are identified.
- Range may include – plastic, metal, nylon, locking, open end, closed end, continuous.
- 1.3 Zips are removed correctly.

### Outcome 2

Fit zips to materials in the industrial textile fabrication industry.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Zips are selected and are prepared for fitting.
- Range may include – metal, nylon, plastic, locking, open end, closed end, continuous, measured, marked out, cut to length.
- 2.2 Material is prepared for zips to be attached.
- Range may include – measured, marked out.
- 2.3 Zips are fitted.
- Range may include – hand stitching, machine stitching, bonded, welded.
