Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate beginner snowboard skills on green terrain at a snowsport area.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Demonstrate straight running with an upright centred stance.
- 1.2 Demonstrate stopping on both toe and heel edges.

- 1.3 Side-slip on both toe and heel edges using flexion-extension and pressure control.
- 1.4 Maintain a skidded traverse and move into a falling leaf.
- 1.5 Demonstrate individual C-turns in both directions.
- 1.6 Demonstrate linked C-turns in both directions with speed control.
