- Definitions  
*Green* means freshly cast sheets, mouldings and castings of fibrous plaster that have yet to be dried.  
*Specifications* refers to documented instructions (oral, written, graphic) and may include any of the following: manufacturer's specifications, recommendations or technical data sheets; material specifications; specifications from a specialist source such as an architect, designer, engineer or a supervisor; site or work specific requirements.
- Credit for this unit standard can be achieved on site through a registered assessor, or off site with an accredited training provider.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Identify the types of fibrous plaster sheets, mouldings, and castings available to industry.

#### Performance criteria

- Types of fibrous plaster sheets are identified and described in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.

- Fibrous plaster mouldings and castings are identified and their use with fibrous plaster and other wall and ceiling linings is described.

**Outcome 2**

Describe the manufacture and storage of fibrous plaster sheets, mouldings, and castings.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 The description identifies the process steps for setting up of moulds.
- 2.2 The description identifies the process steps for mixing and pouring plaster for the manufacture of fibrous plaster sheets, mouldings, and castings.
- 2.3 The description identifies the curing and storage of green sheets, mouldings, and castings.
