Definition

Glazing materials – refer to those materials used to bed, fix, or hold glass in place in a structure.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of glazing materials.

Range glazing materials include – fixings (sprigs, clips, beads), blocks (setting, spacer, distance) glazing putties, glazing tapes, gaskets and wedges, glazing sealant.

Performance criteria

1.1 The physical characteristics of glazing materials are identified and described in terms of the forms in which they are available to the industry.

1.2 Situations in which glazing materials are used are identified and described in terms of their purpose and function.

Range evidence is required for a workplace situation where each item in the outcome range will be used.
