Describe the transport requirements for beehives to new apiary locations.

- 1.2 Describe the relevant emergency procedures in the event of an accident while transporting beehives.

Outcome 2

Prepare beehives for transport and transport beehives.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Check prepare and strap beehives.
- 2.2 Load beehives on to transport vehicle.
- 2.3 Cover and secure load.
- 2.4 Transport beehives to new site.

Outcome 3

Demonstrate knowledge of beehive site requirements and establish beehives at the new site.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Describe entry rights and access to a property.
- 3.2 Describe factors involved in apiary site selection.
Range evidence of five factors is required.
- 3.3 Carry out site inspection and prepare site.
- 3.4 Establish beehives.
