 Evidence is required for a concrete base of at least 4m square.
- 4 All evidence presented in this unit standard must be in accordance with workplace procedures.

Range set levels, excavate.

- 1.3 Lay, level, and compact base material.

- 1.5 Measure, mix or import, place, finish, protect and cure concrete.
- 1.6 Wear personal protective equipment appropriate for the task.
- 1.7 Work safely around other people and machinery working on site.
- 1.8 Clean and store tools and equipment after use.
