Outcome 1

Install and nail a rail panel.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Position posts consistent with fence design.
- 1.2 Maintain consistent spacing between rails throughout the whole panel and in accordance with fence design.
- 1.3 Alternate rail joins on posts where possible, butted neatly or mitred, to maximise strength.
- 1.4 Fix rails with galvanised nails at each post and join with nails skewed in opposing directions as near to edge as is practical.
