Purpose	People credited with this unit standard are able to explain whānau, hapū and iwi in accordance with tikanga.

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Guidance Information

- 1 The basic principles underpinning tikanga are common, but while there are some constants, the details of performance of tikanga, and their explanation, may differ. These differences may be at a whānau, hapū, iwi, marae or rohe level. The context of the learning should include the tikanga of the local mana whenua but learning others' tikanga is also encouraged.
- 2 *Tikanga* are Māori values, processes, practices and procedures exercised by Māori in their daily lives. These reflect the concepts upon which they are based and provide guidelines for appropriate behaviour and conduct in Māori society. They also prescribe consequences for any breaches or when tikanga is not followed. They can be particular to a whānau, hapū, iwi, hapori, marae or rohe.
- 3 All sources of information must be referenced.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Explain whānau, hapū and iwi in accordance with tikanga.

- 1.1 Ngā atua and their importance on whānau, hapū and iwi are explained.
- 1.2 Whakapapa and its importance of whānau, hapū and iwi is explained.
- 1.3 The status of eponymous ancestors for whānau, hapū and iwi is explained.
- 1.4 The marae and its importance to whānau, hapū and iwi are explained.
