Manufacturer's specifications – instructions from the manufacturer which outlines the specifications, parts, maintenance, service schedule, repair and running of specific equipment.

Organisational requirements – instructions to staff on policies and procedures which are documented in memo, electronic or manual format and are available in the workplace.

Primary products food processing operation – covers a meat processing, dairy processing, seafood or baking yeasts manufacturing operation.
- 3 Consistent organisational production output targets apply to the performance of this activity. These may include but are not limited to – hourly output, shift output, daily output.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to operate packaging machines in a primary products food processing operation.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Carry out set up procedure and checks for packaging equipment, and where required, for packaging materials in accordance with organisational requirements and manufacturer's specifications.

- 1.2 Verify product specifications and descriptions to ensure conformity of product in accordance with organisational requirements.

Outcome 2

Operate, clean and maintain packaging equipment in a primary products food processing operation.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Operate packing equipment in accordance with organisational requirements and manufacturer's specifications.
- 2.2 Clean and maintain packing equipment and refill consumables in accordance with organisational requirements and manufacturer's specifications.
