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### Guidance Information

- 1 Tikanga and kawa related to the content of the Whakairo subfield refer to specific interpretations and understandings of whakapapa, te reo, symbolism, concepts and representation within a Whakairo context. They are distinctive from those within the broader context of Te Ao Māori.
- 2 Glossary  
*Mana whenua* – Māori authority over land area or region;  
*Rangi* – sound(s);  
*Kupu* – word(s);  
*Awa* – river;  
*Maunga* – mountain.
- 3 Assessment of this unit standard is to be conducted by a fluent speaker of te reo Māori.

#### Outcome 2

Perform a waiata ā-iwi.

**Performance criteria**

2.1 Waiata ā-iwi is performed in a manner ensuring endorsement for the rangi and kupu.

Range at least one waiata ā-iwi required from a whakairo context.

**Outcome 3**

Explain a waiata ā-iwi.

**Performance criteria**

3.1 Waiata-ā-iwi is explained correctly.

Range at least one waiata-ā-iwi is explained.

**Outcome 4**

Compose whaikōrero for a formal situation.

**Performance criteria**

4.1 Whaikōrero establishing mana whenua status are composed in a manner ensuring endorsement for grammatical structure and kaupapa by a fluent speaker of te reo.

Range including but not limited to – maunga, awa, iwi, waka, nuances.

**Outcome 5**

Present whaikōrero in a formal situation.

**Performance criteria**

5.1 Whaikōrero establishing mana whenua status are presented according to grammatical structure and kaupapa.

Range including but not limited to – maunga, awa, iwi, hapū.
