- 2 *Demonstrate knowledge* involves describing how pasture/crop management practices are carried out.

Demonstrate in-depth knowledge involves explaining why pasture/crop management practices or steps within practices are carried out.

Demonstrate comprehensive knowledge involves applying knowledge of pasture/crop management practices. This may involve comparing and contrasting or justifying management practices.

3 *Pasture* refers to grass/clover mix used to feed livestock.

- 4 *Crop* refers to a field-grown, annual crop eg an arable crop such as wheat, a forage crop such as kale, or a processed crop such as potatoes and field tomatoes.
- 5 *Pasture/crop management practices* are those management practices that impact on pasture/crop production, from establishment and maintenance through to harvesting, grazing, and conservation.
