Explanatory Notes

- Technology* refers to sophisticated hardware (eg camera, editing suite, sound desk, computer) or software (eg computer programs such as PageMaker, Photoshop, Premiere, iMovie, Peak, Audition) commonly used in media production.
- Competently* means that students can perform a range of basic tasks in media production.
- Skilfully* means that students can effectively perform a range of tasks in media production.
- Expertly* means that students can show mastery of a range of advanced tasks in media production.
- This achievement standard could be linked with AS90765 Media Studies 2.6, but could also be assessed independently.

- 6 Where assessment of this standard is based on group production of a single text, the contribution of each student must be significant, clearly identifiable and assessable.
