- comprehensive planning for a directed product-based business activity
 - carrying out a business activity
 - integrating relevant business knowledge
 - integrating a Māori concept(s) where relevant
 - reflecting on how well the business activity was performed and making recommendations of what could be improved in the future.
- 6 Explanation of terms:
- A *classroom context* means within a classroom, year level, department or faculty.
 - A *product-based business activity* refers to the production and/or adding value leading to the sale of a good.
