- 3 *Media texts* include but are not limited to: television programme, radio programme, film, feature article, web page, music video.
- 4 *Narrative features* that contribute to the narrative may relate to:
- mise en scène
 - visual elements
 - character
 - conflict or opposition
 - narrative perspective
 - symbols, motifs, or themes
 - sound
 - setting
 - manipulation of time
 - narrative structure.
