1. Analyse how **language techniques** supported the development of a strong idea or ideas in at least TWO short texts.
2. Analyse how **symbols** were used to represent aspects of character in at least TWO short texts.
3. Analyse how the writer(s) created and maintained tension through **conflict** in at least TWO short texts.
4. Analyse how **setting** was used to support an interesting idea or ideas in at least TWO short texts.
5. Analyse how a similar **idea** has been developed in different ways across at least TWO short texts.
6. Analyse **techniques** the writer(s) used to attract and maintain readers' interest in at least TWO short texts.
7. Analyse how **imagery** created strong emotion in readers in at least TWO short texts.
8. Analyse how **characters or individuals** changed in response to an important event or events in at least TWO short texts.
