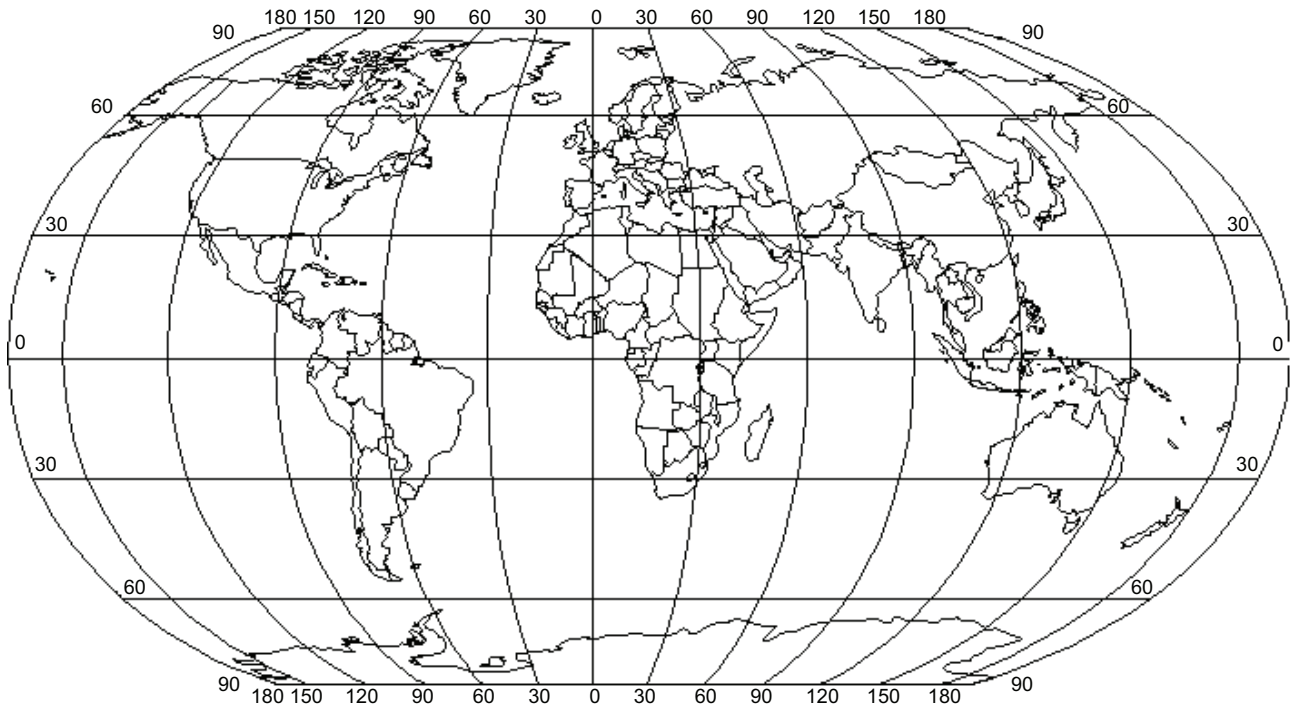

QUESTION ONE: CHARACTERISTICS

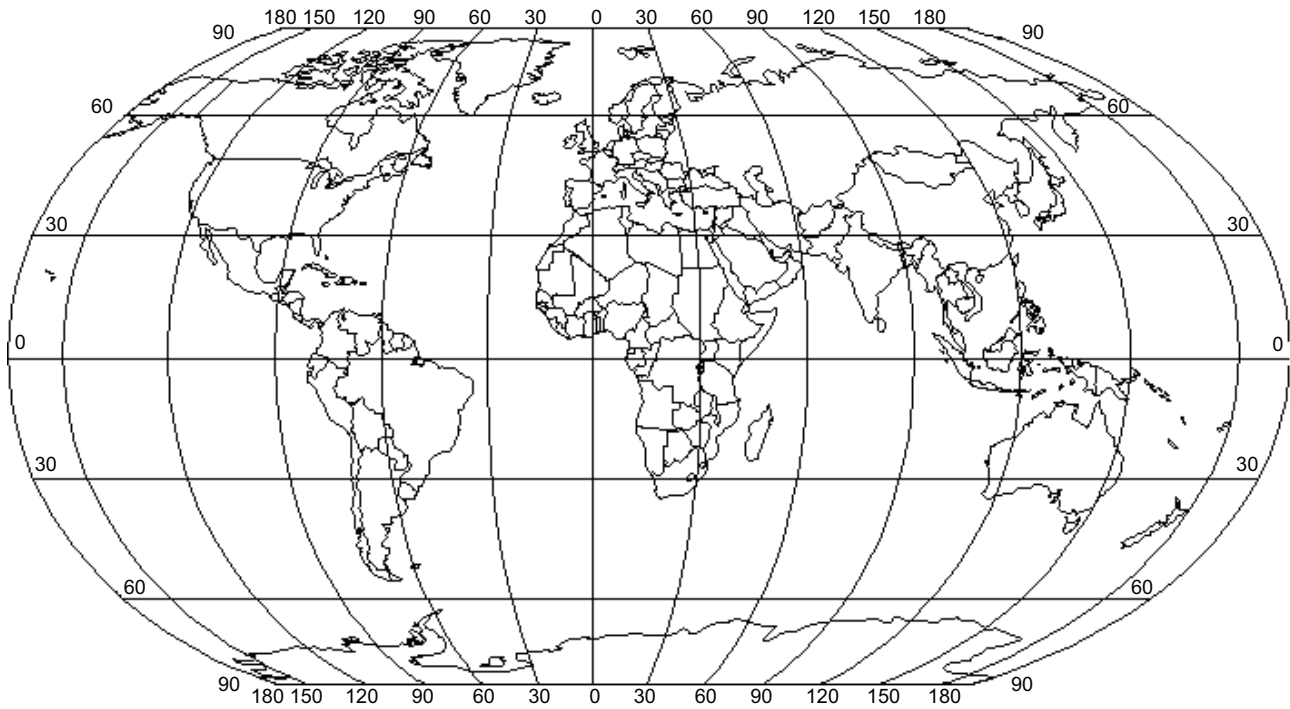


