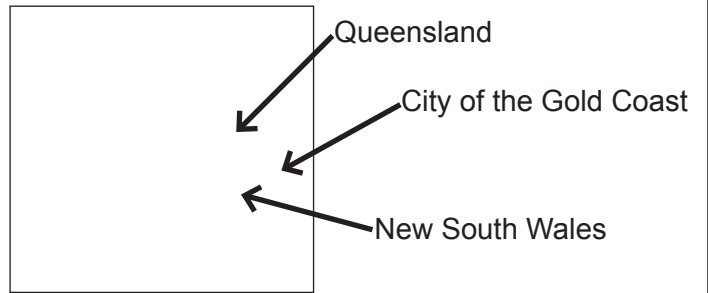

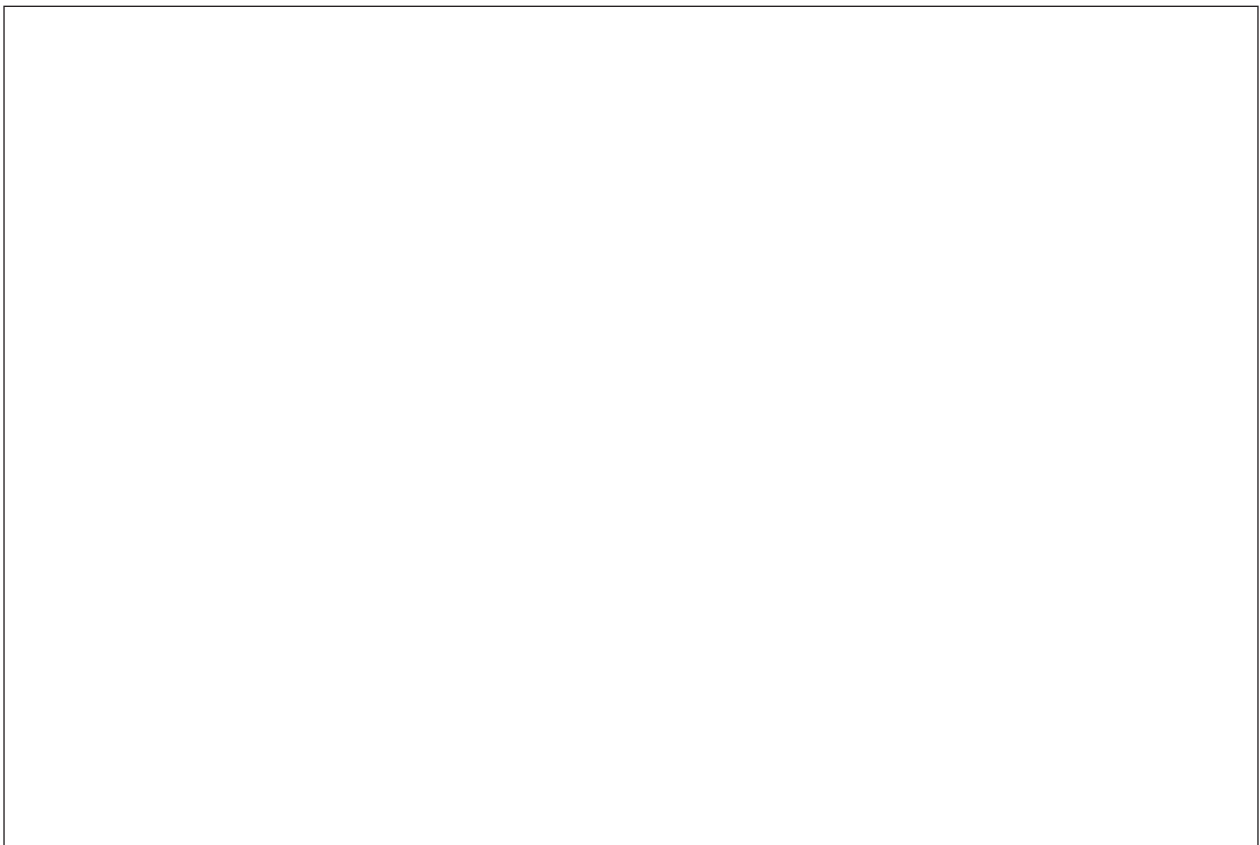
Resource A: Introduction to the City of the Gold Coast

The Gold Coast is a coastal city in south-east Queensland.

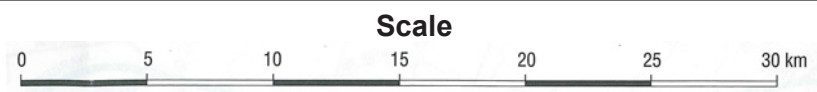
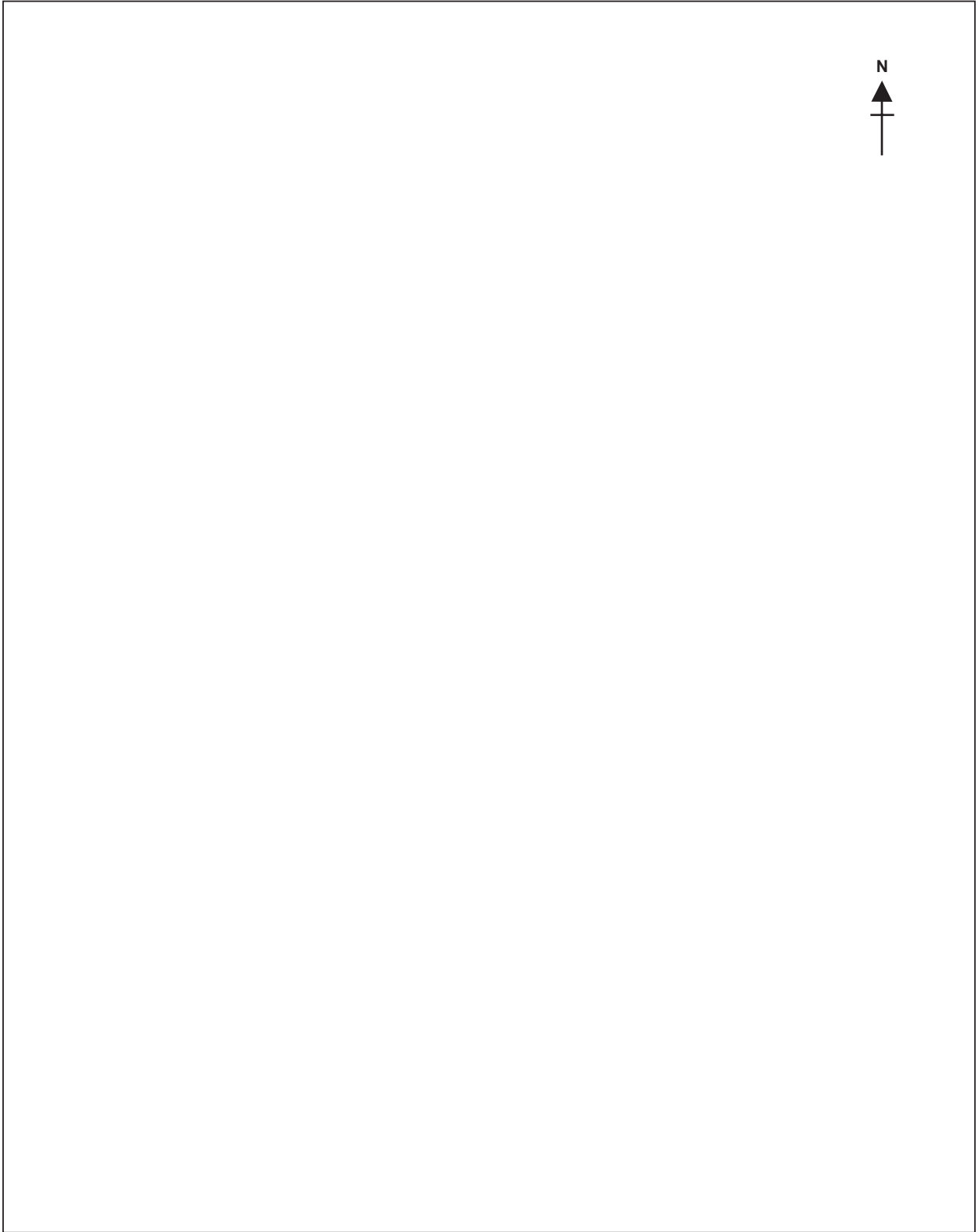

Resource B: Australia and Europe – Area Size Comparison

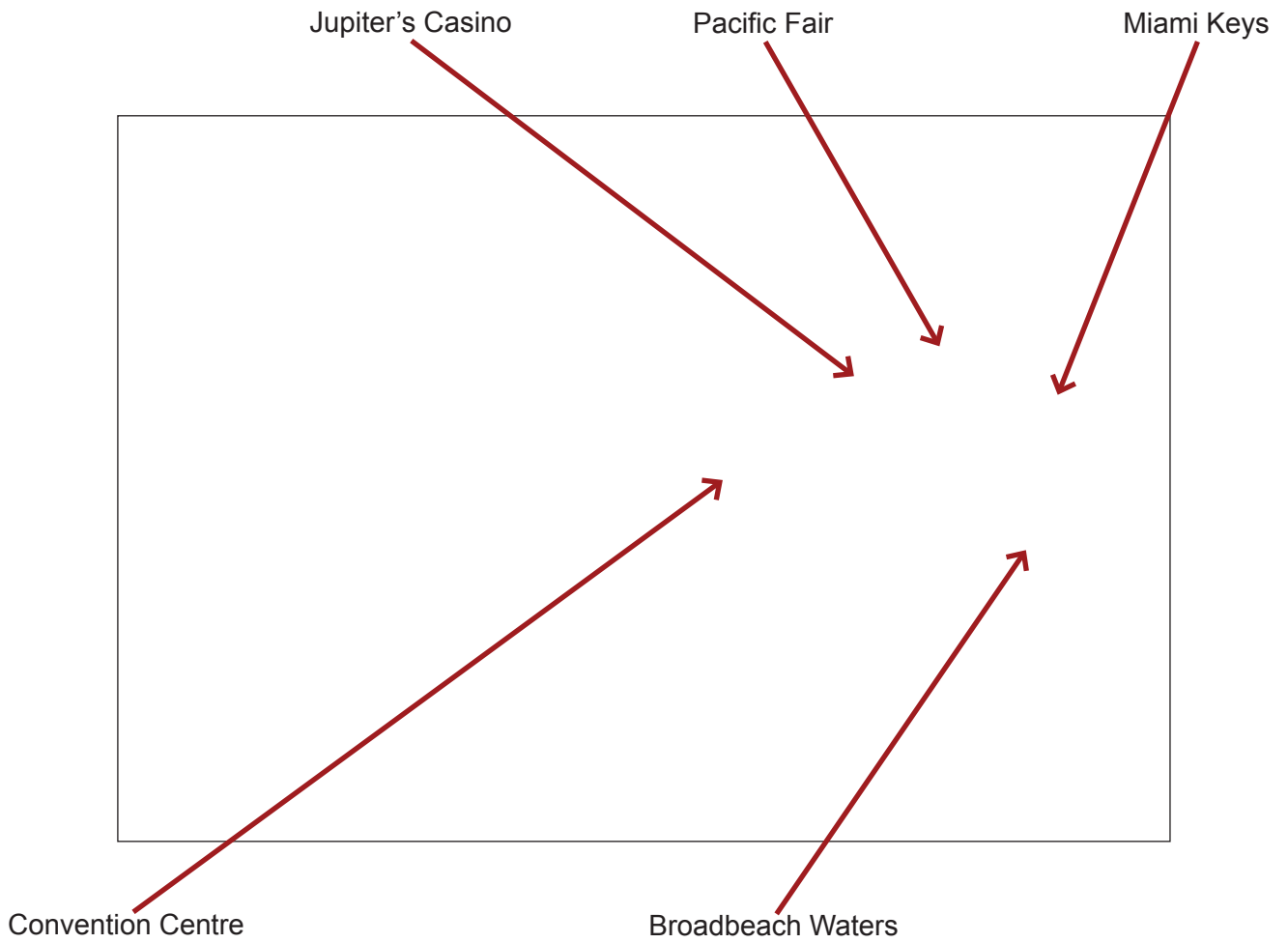


Resource C: Map of the Gold Coast

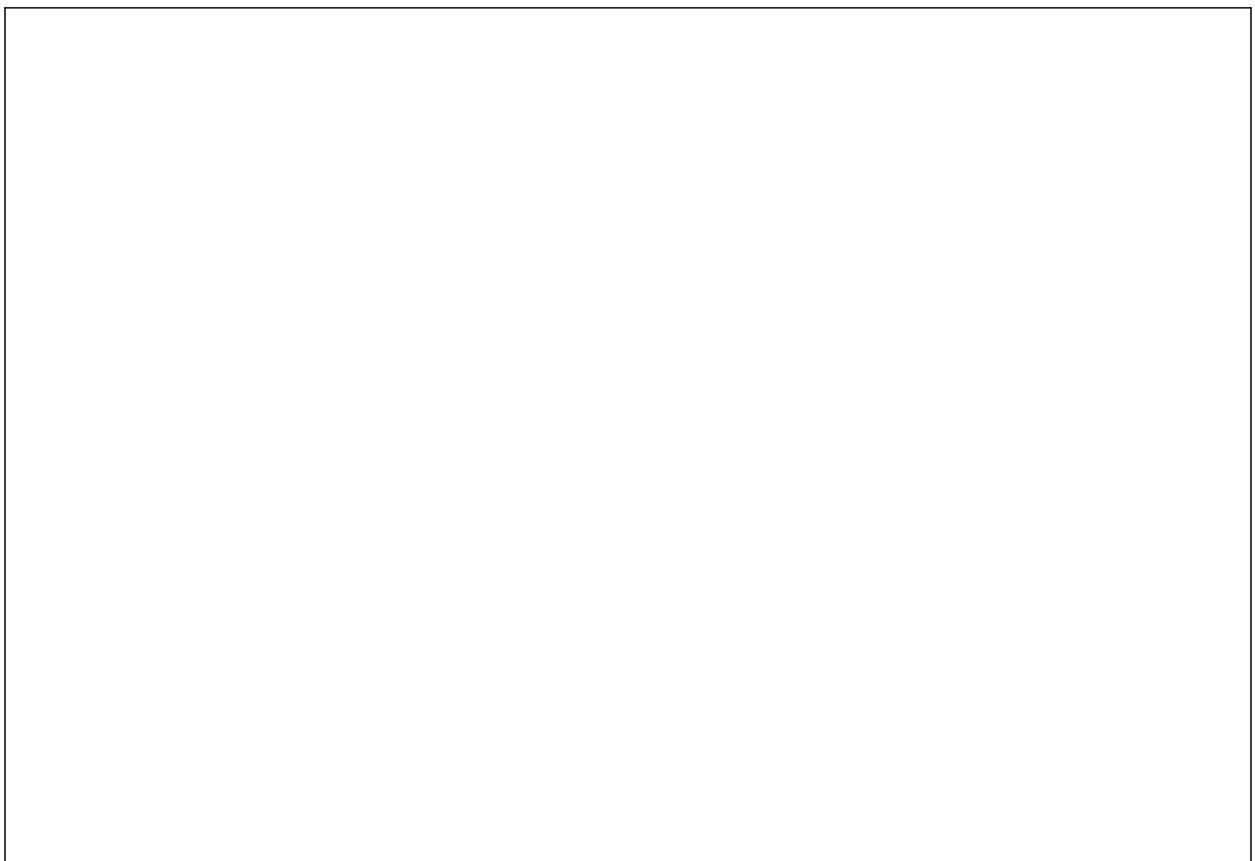

Resource E: Map of Broadbeach Waters and Miami Keys



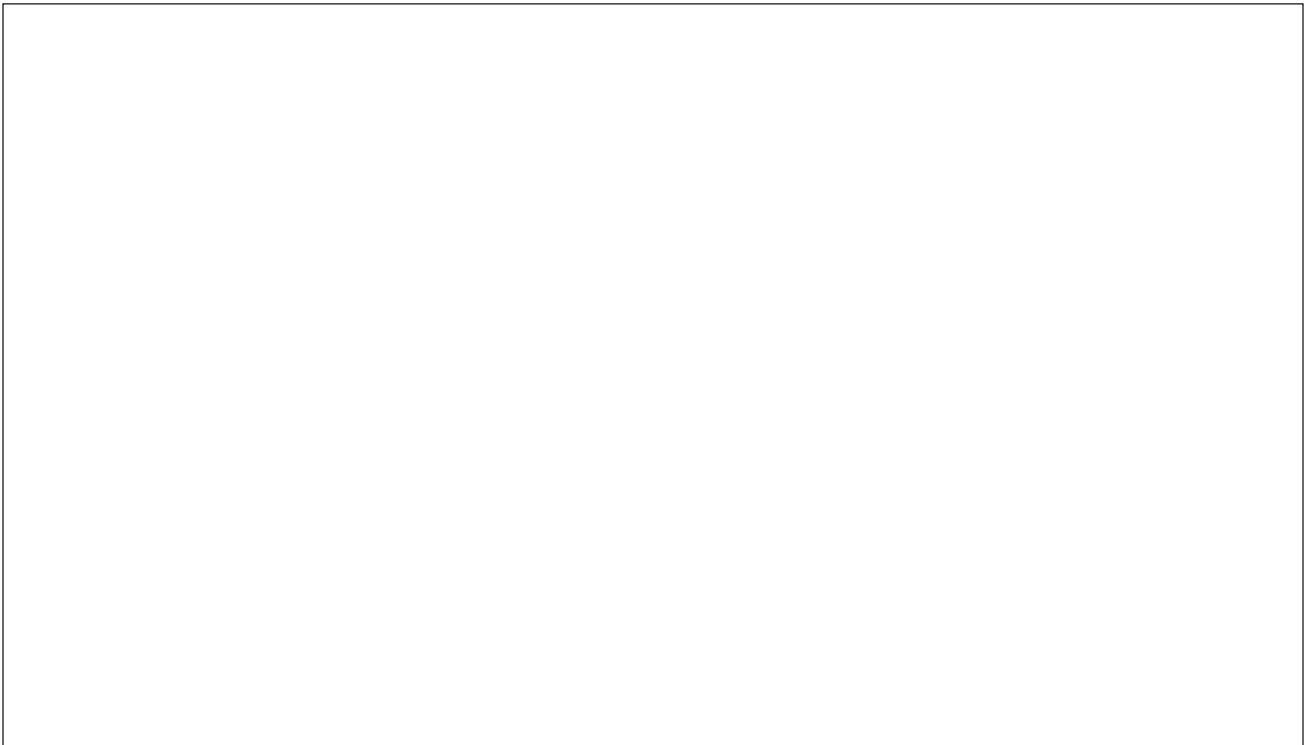

The Gold Coast has the largest concentration of theme parks in the world and this, along with the whale watching cruises on offer, make it an exciting place to visit.

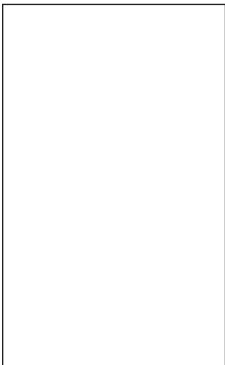
Each year, around 10 000 whales per year migrate past the Gold Coast over the course of the five-month whale watching period.

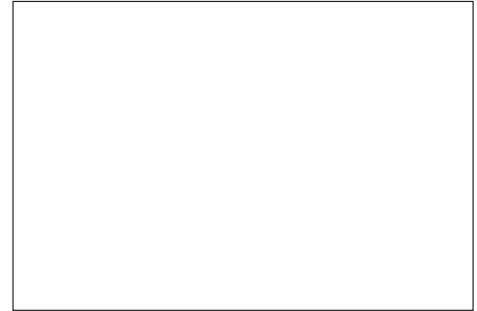
The Commonwealth Games Corporation will host approximately 6 500 athletes and team officials from more than 70 Commonwealth countries.
