**QUESTION****Savannah's Scenario**

Savannah is a Year 10 student at Riverview College and has many close friends. She has just been selected in the 1st XI hockey team and is very excited because she is the youngest member of the team.

Savannah does not see her dad very often as he lives in Australia, but she is close to her mum, who is very supportive of her school and sporting endeavours. Her mum spends most of her evenings chatting to her friends on the phone though, so Savannah has been spending a lot more time on social media websites as she has unlimited Wi-Fi access at home. She has started taking photos of herself and her friends at school with the new smart phone she got for her birthday, and posting them on her Facebook and Instagram pages to connect with friends and acquaintances.

Savannah has recently noticed some senior students have started making nasty comments about the photos she has posted. Some other students at Riverview College have also spotted some of the comments that have been made about Savannah. The school guidance counsellor, Mr Lee, has already had students approach him with their concerns about student online behaviour, and has also had discussions about this with the school's health advice team, who raised the issue at their last meeting. He is concerned that online bullying behaviour is happening more and more often.
