Resource A: Definition of Discrimination

Discrimination is the prejudicial treatment of an individual based on their actual or perceived membership in a certain group or category, “in a way that is worse than the way people are usually treated”. It involves the group’s initial reaction or interaction, influencing the individual’s actual behaviour towards the group or the group leader, restricting members of one group from opportunities or privileges that are available to another group, leading to the exclusion of the individual or entities based on logical or irrational decision making.

Resource B: The Human Rights Commission and the School Formal



Human Rights Commission
Te Kāhui Tika Tangata

If the Human Rights Commission receives a complaint that a person has been excluded from attending a school formal because they wanted to attend with a partner of the same sex, this could raise questions of possible unlawful discrimination under the Human Rights Act.

If such a complaint were received, the Commission would seek to mediate the matter through its informal, confidential, and free disputes resolution process. If this process did not arrive at a resolution, the parties would have the right to take the complaint to the Human Rights Review Tribunal.
