- (b) Find the value(s) of r such that the equation $x^2 + 4rx + r = 0$ has only one solution.

- (c) Solve the following equation for x in terms of g .

$$2\sqrt{x} - 5 = \sqrt{4x - g}$$

- (e) Find the Cartesian equation of the locus described by $|z + i|^2 + |z - i|^2 = 10$.
Write your solution in the form $x^2 + y^2 = k$.
