Ka haere a Katarina rāua ko Kui ki te hī ika (Katarina and Kui go fishing)

I oho moata au mō tā māua ko Kui haerenga, engari kua taka ā roto! I maumahara au kua pau katoa te māunu. Nā te kuri haututū te māunu i kai. Tōna tinihanga hoki!

I te taenga mai o tōku kuia i heke ōku roimata. I te whakaaro au, tērā pea, kāore māua e haere, nā te mea, kore kau he māunu.

I kī mai tōku kuia, "Hine roriori! Kāore e kore he māunu anō kei te whakatio."

Ka menemene katoa au. Kua tau tōku mauri. "Me haere tere tāua, e Kui!" I haere tōtika māua ki te wahapū.

Whakamāramatia mai pēhea ngā piropiro a Katarina i whakarerekē ai, ā, he aha te take i whakarerekē ai?

Ko wai ia? (*Who was that?*)

I te taenga atu ki te wahapū, i kite au i tētahi tangata. Ko wai ia? He roa, he mingimingi ōna makawe. I te whakaaro au – Ko Troy Kingi ia? Ahakoa he rite tonu ōna makawe ki ngā makawe o Troy Kingi, kāore ōna pāhau.

I titiro anō au ... he nui, he teitei ia. Tērā pea, ko David Leti ia? Engari, he poto rawa ūna makawe.

Kātahi ia ka hao i tētahi ika tino nui rawa! Auē! Tōna kaha hoki ki te hī i tētahi ika pērā!
Kātahi au ka mōhio ko wai ia, ko Māui! Nā te mea, he roa ūna makawē, he nui tōna tinana, ā,
he nui rawa te ika! He rite tonu taua ika ki tētahi motu!

I karanga atu au ki a ia, "Kia ora," engari, kua ngaro atu!

I hea ia? Kātahi au ka kite i a ia mā runga motokā ... tōna tere hoki! Ko Māui tinihangā!

I pōhēhē a Katarina i mōhio ia ko wai te tangata e tū ana ki te wahapū. Kātahi ka tau te whakaaro ko wai te tangata. Whakamaramatia mai tana kōwhiringa.

Read the text below, and refer to it in your answer.

kua taka te kapa	the penny has dropped; I get it now
Ka pū te ruha, ka hao te rangatahi.	When the old net is cast aside, the new net goes fishing.

He raru kei te haere (*Trouble is brewing*)

I tīmata pai tā māua rā. He rā mokopuna. I whiti te rā, ā kāore te hau e pupuhi ana.

Kua tīmata māua ki te hī ika, engari kāore e roa, ka auē a Kui. "He raru kei te haere, e hine."

Ka mauria mai e ia tana rākau hī ika pāwhati. Kua pakaru kē! “Tēnā pea, me waea atu au ki a Koro kia mauria mai tētahi atu rākau hī ika!”

“Auē, e rere ana te wā, e Kui. Ehara i te mea ka kite tāua i a tāua i ngā wā katoa! He tangata pukumahi koe, e Kui! Ki te tatari tāua ki a Koro, he moumou te wā!”

“Āna, e hine, he whakaaro anō tōku. Me haere tāua ki tētahi toa. Ka hoko au i tētahi rākau hī ika hou.”
