## ASPECTS OF GOTHIC ART (c.1120–1420)

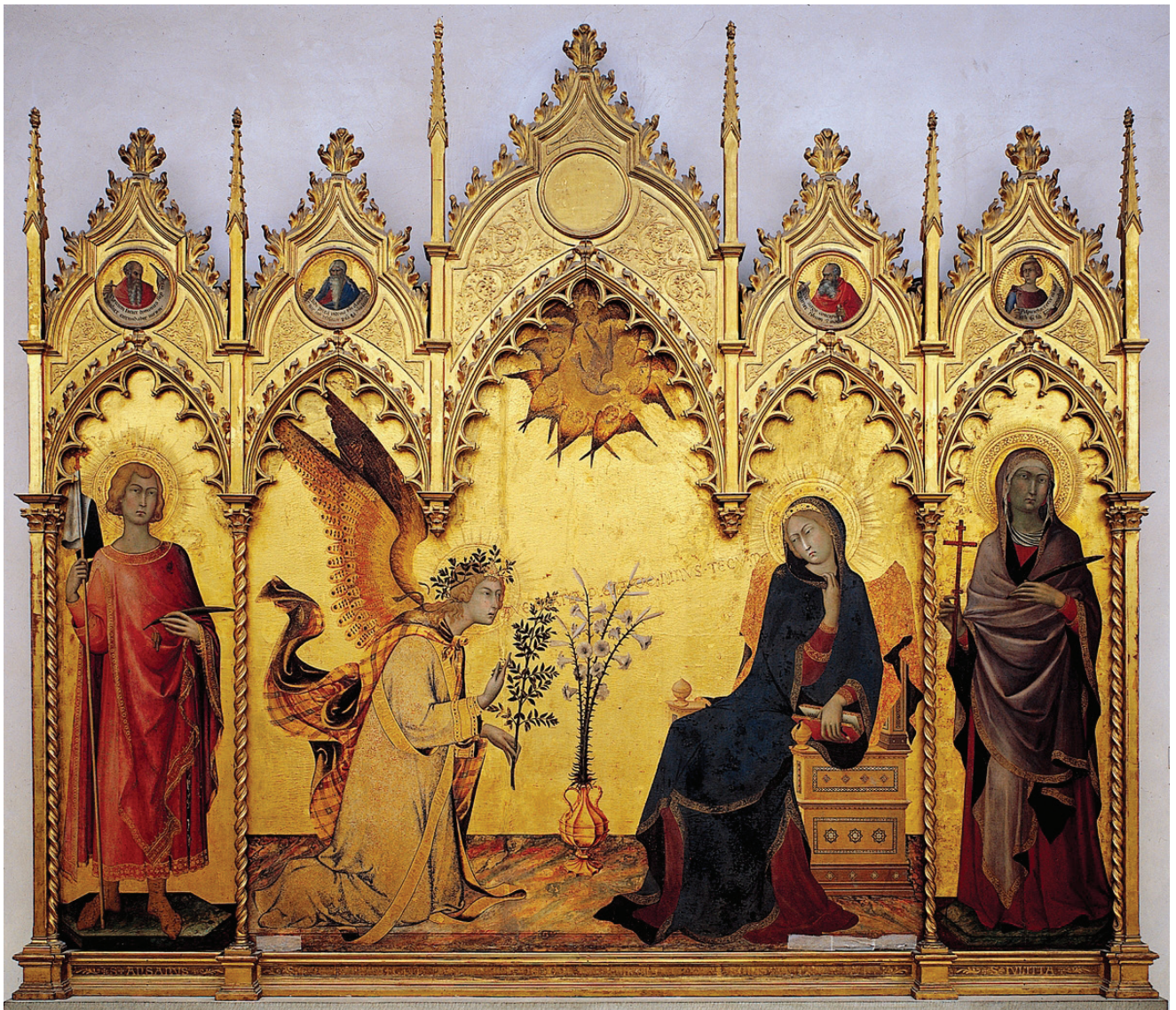

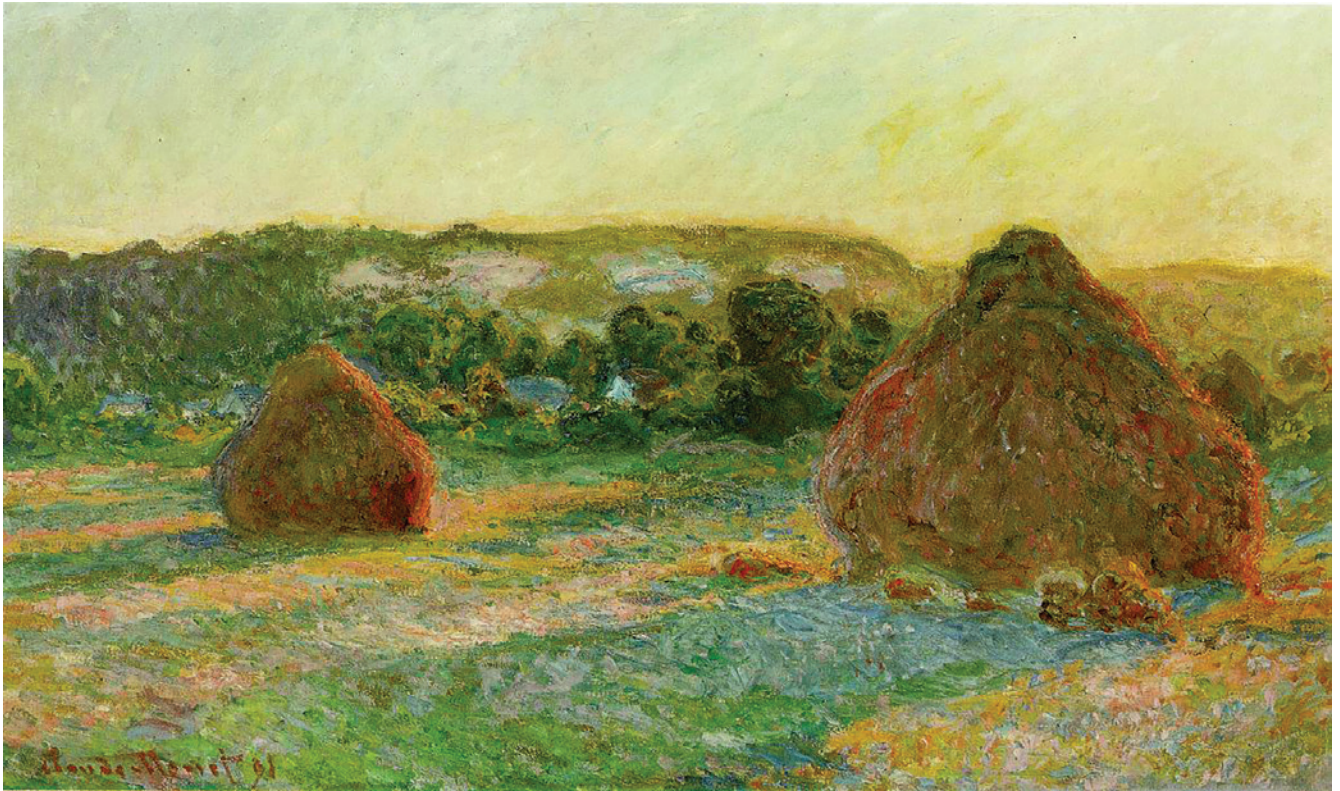

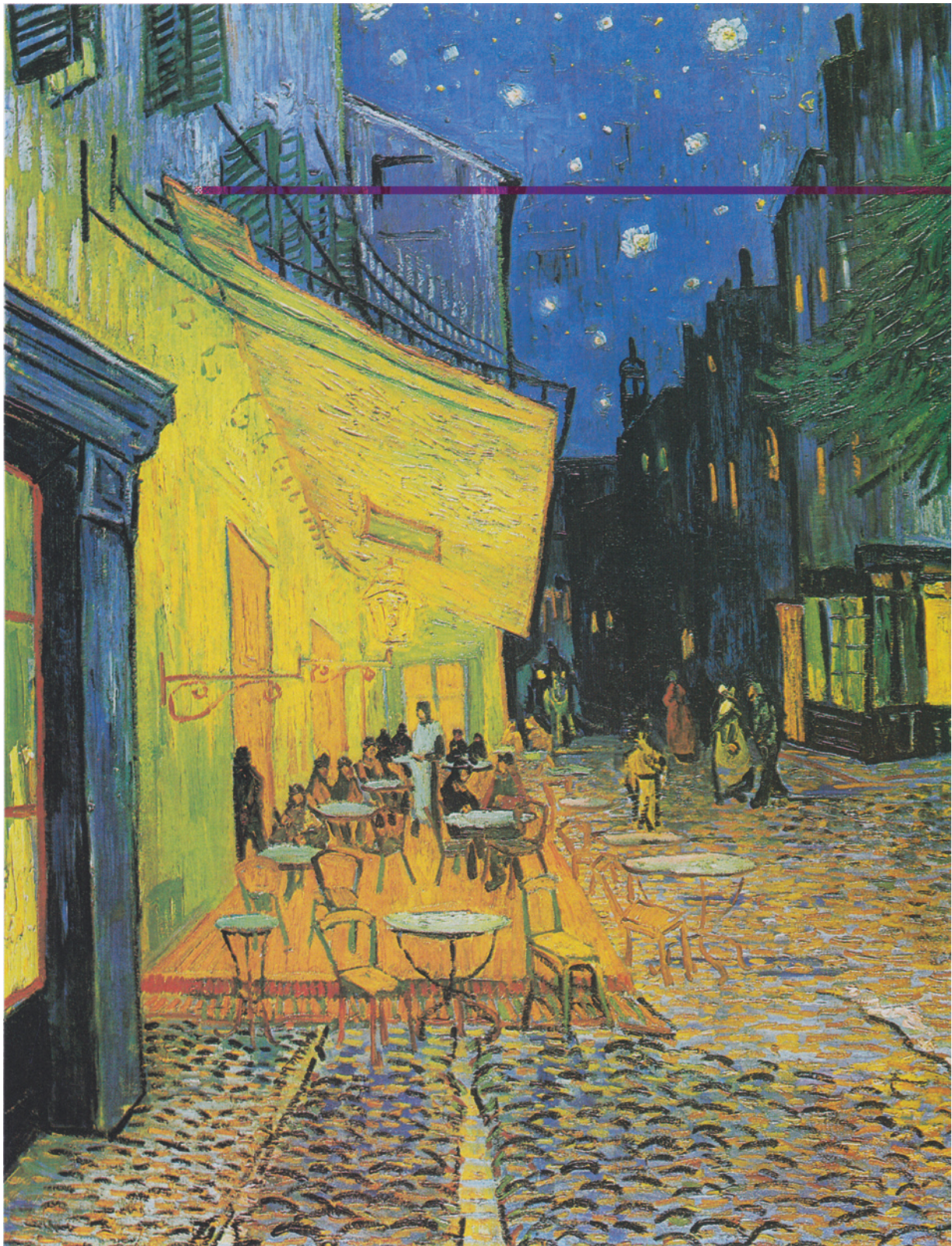

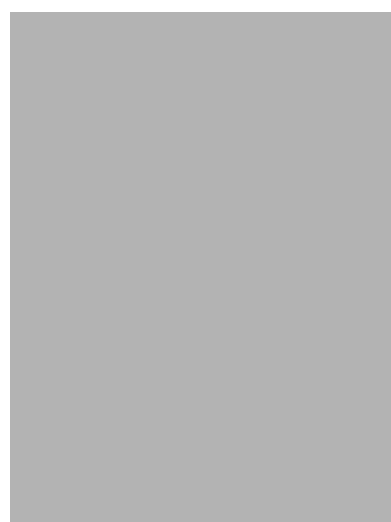
