1. Te haerenga ki tāwāhi

Kua oti atu te KOWHEORI-19, ā, kua whakatūwherahia ngā kūaha ki te ao kia haere. Kāore koe i te hiahia ki te tatari. Tēnā, tuhia tētahi mahere haere: ka haere koe ki hea, ā, ka aha koe. Whakamāramatia mai: he aha te take ka haere ai koe ki ēnei wāhi.

2. Tētahi pakihi hou
